YOUNG CREATORS (STEAM)

Where Science meets Imagination. Campers explore the exciting world of Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics (STEAM) through hands-on projects — coding, design, robotics, art, and creative problem-solving. Ideal for curious minds who love to make, build, and create.

The L&E Young Creators program combines Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics (STEAM) to spark curiosity and creativity. Participants explore how innovation and imagination can change the world — whether that's through building robots, designing eco-solutions, coding music, or creating visual art that tells a story.

L&E Young Creators inspires campers to become designers, makers, and thinkers. Each day is filled with hands-on experiments, creative challenges, and team projects that connect science and art in exciting, unexpected ways. Participants will:

- Build and program robots to complete missions

- Design artistic structures and kinetic sculptures
- Explore light, colour, and motion through physics and art
- Code interactive music and animations
- Create sustainable designs for the future
- Exhibit their work in the Innovation & Arts Expo at week's end

YOUNG GLOBAL LEADERS

Young Global Leaders (YGL) & Life Skills Course is a week long programme where young people will be given the opportunity to discover their own potential by taking part in various sessions focusing on communication, language and teamwork. YGL is a fun yet challenging programme that aids campers with creating and bettering their skills that will set them up for life. The YGL & Life Skills course is for 13-16 year olds. We focus on leadership and teamwork as well as recognising vital life skills:

- Ability to take constructive feedback





ENGLISH LANGUAGE COURSE

Learn English in a fun, interactive, and immersive environment. Through project-based learning, games, and real conversations, campers build confidence and fluency — both inside and outside the classroom.

Perfect for international campers looking to improve their spoken and written English while joining the full L&E experience. Students are placed by ability to a maximum of 10 in each class. The classes are every morning Monday to Friday (these can be open to flexibility).

A careful balance of activities are designed to increase the student's English language, grammar and vocabulary. The students will improve their skills in reading, writing, listening and speaking the English language.

TEEN TRAVEL

L&E Teen Travel gives young people the life skills for their future journey. The focus is to prepare and inspire Teens for their future travels (can combine with World Camps).

It's a chance for them to step out into the world and learn life changing and practical skills with the freedom of feeling safe with our experienced guides.

Embark on an unforgettable journey with our Teen Travel Tours, designed to ignite curiosity and cultivate a sense of adventure among young explorers. From the vibrant streets of bustling cities to the serene landscapes of exotic destinations, teens will immerse themselves in diverse cultures, forge lifelong friendships, and gain invaluable life skills.

Our expertly crafted itineraries blend exciting activities with meaningful learning experiences, fostering personal growth and global awareness.

Our 3 Main Objectives:

- To prepare young people (13-17) for any travelling they do in the future (this can be combined with World Camps). This gives Teens the chance to make their own decisions and understand what it's like to be part of a diverse group.
- To give parents the reassurance that their children are learning valuable life skills in a safe, secure but exciting and challenging environment.

This is an exciting way for teen travellers to 'dip their toes in the water' – to inspire them and to equip them with the skills and knowledge to travel well.

This half way house between full independence and parental guidance will enhance skills such as communication, compromise and working in a group.

We know it will give them the confidence and knowledge they'll need when the time comes to set off for an adventure on their own.

Travel Mentors

The Travel Mentors main job is to keep the teenagers safe. The mentors are there to encourage and support the group rather than hold them back. Our Travel Mentors are; First Aid trained, DBS Certified, fully trained and well travelled. English is also their 1st language and they are caring, fun and responsible mentors.

Accommodation

It will be a mix of youth hostels and hotels. The travellers may help choose their own accommodation but the Travel Mentors will have the final say. The two most important criteria for the accommodations are that they are safe and clean. They will also take into consideration the physical layout of the accommodation to help ease their ability to supervise.

What Is Included

All transportation during the trip, rail passes, accommodations, all breakfasts and evening meals, trip related activities and trip related activity admissions.

Not Included: Arrival & Departure Airfare, insurance, lunches, visas & visa application fees.

LOCAL BURSARIES

We are incredibly excited about offering discounts to local children that attend our L&E World Camps in UK and Canada.

Connecting with young people from around the world is incredibly important, that's why we believe that providing local children with this opportunity and immersing our international children in a native English speaking environment will create a truly enriching experience.

We have limited places available, with up to a 25% discount available. This discount is available upon checkout with proof of residence. The application is only available to children who attend UK, Canadian and or BC Schools.



FAQS FOR PARENTS

How Long Should We Come For?

This depends on your child. The questions you should ask yourself when thinking about this are: How old are they? Have they been away from home before? What do they want out of a summer camp? Do they have friends or siblings coming with them? We are always available for advice, we are experienced and can help you work through these decisions so that making the best decision for your child is simple.

When Do I Need To Book?

On each course we accept a limited number of children who share the same mother tongue and we give priority to returning students. Because of this, places for some nationalities are fully booked early in the year. You can check to see if a place is available by completing the first part of our Booking Form. We occasionally get cancellations so we operate a waitlist. If you need a visa this can take longer than expected so please allow plenty of time.

Will My Child Improve Their English Language?

The simple answer is... YES, absolutely, for certain. L&E is an English speaking camp. Our Staff speak English and all of our activities are ran in English. We also have L&E English Language Lessons available each morning. If you are coming from overseas we can guarantee your child will receive a full English immersible experience at L&E!

What If My Child Gets Homesick?

We want each and every child to settle in as quickly as possible and we do this by creating

an environment which is nurturing and safe. However, it is very natural for a child to get homesick in the first few days of camp but usually it only lasts for a couple of days. We provide full support, helping your child overcome any homesickness and becoming stronger and self-assured in the process.

Is There A Time When I Can Contact My Child?

There is 40 minutes set aside each day in which you can contact your child (Usually after the evening meal – 6.30pm). If your child doesn't bring a phone with them you can call the Camp Director who will help you reach your child. Of course if there is an emergency, or you need to contact your child you will have the contact details of the Camp Director who will assist you. The Camp Office will also have access to a telephone number 24 hours a day.

Do You Offer Discounts?

Yes we do! We offer a 5% sibling discount when booking two or more of your children onto our camps. We also offer a Local Bursary for British and Canadian families attending World Camp UK & Canada respectively.
